**AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 66 OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS,
2016**

The Minister for the Public Service and Administration has, under section 41 of the Public Service Act, 1994 (promulgated under Proclamation No. 103 of 1994), amended regulation 66 of the Public Service Regulations, 2016 (published under Government Notice No. R. 877 of 29 July 2016), as set out in the attached Schedule and shall come into operation on the date of publication thereof in the *Gazette*.

SCHEDULE**Definition**

1. In this Schedule "the Regulations" means the Public Service Regulations, 2016 published in Government Notice No. R. 877 of 29 July 2016.

Amendment of regulation 66 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 66 of the Regulations is hereby amended—
- (a) by the substitution in subregulation (1) for paragraph (a) of the following paragraph:
- " (a) an appointment in terms of section 9 of the Act for [—
 **] the term of office of the incumbent executive authority
 or Deputy Minister which will terminate at the end of
 the first month after the month which the term of that
 executive authority or Deputy Minister terminates for
 any reason; [or
 (ii) a period not exceeding three years;]"; and**

(b) by the addition of the following subregulation:

"(4) Any employee employed in terms of subregulation (1)(a) shall not be transferred within the department or to another department without complying with regulation 65(1)(3) and (4)."

Amendment of Annexure 1 to the Regulations

3. Annexure 1 to the Regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following item:

"(4) Any employee, who at the time of the coming into effect of the Public Service Amendment Regulations, 2018, is employed in terms of regulation 66(1)(a) of the Regulations shall not, for the period of her or his employment, be transferred within the department or to another department without complying with regulation 65(1)(3) and (4)."

Short title and commencement

4. These Regulations shall be called the Public Service Amendment Regulations, 2018, and shall come into operation on the publication thereof in the *Gazette*.
